



- Attendance is vital to being a school community member and it is an important life skill (dependability).
- Students with attendance problems (10% of school year) become disengaged, falling behind academically, and potential to drop out increases.
- Students who are in school: 64% are proficient readers by the end of third grade

In East Sandy, 148 students are not “On Track” based on student attendance data. Last year, 43 students were absent 12 or more days and 105 students were absent 6-11 days.

- Three tardies equals an absence
- This included excused and inexcused absence.

East Sandy’s goal is 90% attendance.

#### Standard Notification Schedule

3-5 days: Parent Phone Call or Email from teacher

5-7 days: Notification of Attendance Issue Letter 1

9-11 days: Notice of Compulsory Education Violation Letter 2?
