### Principals Report:

1. COVID Plan and Questions  
*Are there going to be changes in registration for in school or online? November 1-5, we are re-registering as online or in school learning. There will be changes in school. There might be shuffling. There will be another at the end of term 2.*  
*How is Canvas for parents? It is doing much better, compared to spring*
2. ABS Update  
*Things are going well. It has been smooth. We are working on getting kids into the gen ed classrooms.*
3. Council Review Land trust & TSSP – 2020-2021
  - We have purchased three additional sets (30 each) of Chromebooks
    - All Chromebooks are on back order and we may not receive them until closer to the end of the year
  - We have purchased and distributed Second Step curriculum so all teachers now have it
  - Tier II aids (curriculum interventionists) are pushing into classrooms and working with groups of students in each grade level
  - We did not purchase Saxon Phonics because the district purchased a new program
    - This money will be reallocated elsewhere

- MTSS assistants have check-in/check-out process up and running. They are teaching the CEO trait lessons. Scheduled to be in classrooms to help collect data if teachers request it. Helping in the lunchroom every day.
  - Counselor hired and working with our students. She has a caseload of about 40 students. Pushes into each class to do social/emotional learning. Helping with restorative circles.
