  - Teachers are starting to work on their goals for next year
  - Some of our funding is currently going to our SEL staff, including our school counselor and our behavior aids, we need to start thinking if we still want to go in this direction.
  - Technology for the lower grades (1 to 1)
  - ELA kits for Kinder and possibly first

5. Reports safety drills
  - 100% participation on all drills.

6. Approval of SNAP Plan
